Early Morning Devotion

Read Theme Scripture: Col 1:13

"Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son"

Read Scripture of the Day: **Psalm 63:1-3**

- Meditate on this scripture before you pray.
- Pray with a desire to seek God and relationship with him. Resist asking God for things and 'stuff'.

Morning Reflection with Journal Questions:
